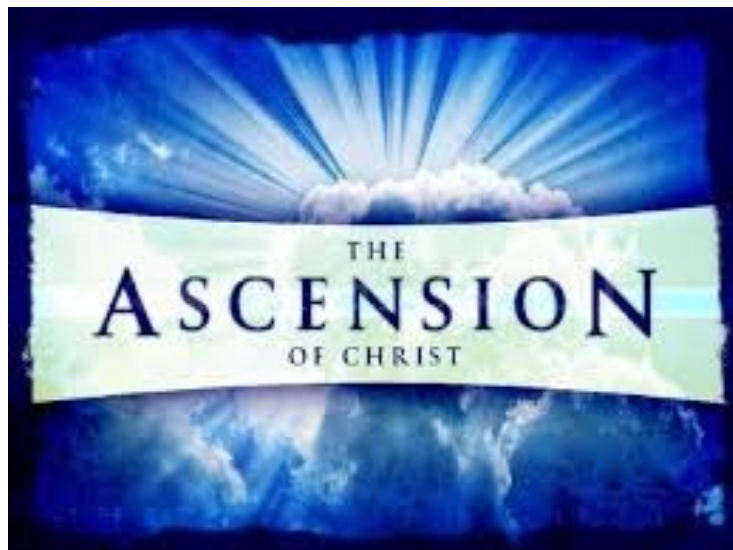

## **Thwing and Octon Show is Back!**

After an 11 year gap the Thwing and Octon Village Show will be back this year. The last show was held in 2008 and the committee decided at that time that the amount of work involved was too great for the few committee members at that time.

After a great deal of discussion by the current committee it was decided to reinstate the Village Show, albeit in a much smaller format.

The 2019 show will be held on Sunday 25th August in the Church Reading Rooms, and will feature 39 classes, some 25 less from the last time it was held.

Chairman of the committee, Chris Oxtoby, explained that during the last 11 years we seem to have quite an influx of new villagers who probably have never experienced an event of this nature, this he said "would be an ideal opportunity for them to get involved with life within the village and is an ideal way for them to get to know other people from the area".

The show will have the usual classes including Flowers, Vegetables, Handicraft and Children's classes. Chris said that "the news that the show was being reintroduced seemed to be causing a real buzz in the villages, people seem to be planning their gardens, what to plant and even practicing cookery skills".

Chris stressed "this a real fun show and would not be run to any WI or Horticultural rulings, the winners will be the best exhibits as deemed by the judges!"

Entry forms will be available in due course, until then the arrangements are being finalised for a "Great FUN Show"
